

# Paybas, Normandie, Bretagne & Paris

## ITINERARY

Day	Routing
1.	Arrival at Amsterdam, meet with the tour manager and the rest of the group at hotel. Short night ride in town to see Dam Square.
2.	After a short visit in the city, we move southern to Dutch capital Den Haag, Short visit before we move again to picturesque -and full of canals- Ghent.
3.	Let's move forwards in up-west France for short visits in Dunkerque and Dieppe, both towns with "heavy" historical background.
4.	Fecamp is our next town-visit stop, and we keep going to Le Havre, the famous French port. Honfleur and Deauville are our next steps where you will not want to leave from... At the end of this wonderful day we arrive in Caen.
5.	We shall visit the "D" Day Normandie invasion lands close to Bayex. We continue to worldwide famous Mont Saint Michel and we end up in Saint Malo.
6.	The area is of the most beautiful in whole Europe, and that's why we stay for another night here.
7.	Passing through Rennes and Le Mans ..... it's time to reach Paris. Arrival and if there is time available we make a night car-ride for a light orientation in the French capital. Among others you will see Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysees, Louvre Palace and La Defense
8.	Departure from Paris airport.
